## HACIENDA RECREATIONAL CLUB POOL RULES as of 5-28-15

- 1. Children under the age of 14 must be supervised by an adult member (18 or over) at all times when the lifeguard is not on duty. No children under the age of 7 may be left unattended at any time.
- 2. The pool is closed at 10:00 p.m. to anyone under 18 that is not accompanied by an adult member.
- 3. There is a \$1.00 charge for each non-member at the pool, including non-swimmers and guests at parties. A guest is anyone not normally a resident of your household. Persons residing in your home for two or more consecutive days will be considered a member of your family.
- 4. No pets other than service dogs are allowed in the pool area.
- 5. No glass allowed on pool deck or in the pool.
- 6. There is a maximum weight limit of 250 pounds on the diving board.
- 7. Parties:
  - Definition: Over 10 guests. \$10 charge for each party with up to 25 guests and a \$35 charge for each party with 26-35 guests. No parties on Sundays or holidays.
  - How to reserve: Approval will only be granted to members in good standing. Approval must be granted by the treasurer (hacrecclub@gmail.com).
  - Once approved, a notice must be posted on the bulletin board one week prior to the party and contain the following information.
    - ✓ Name and phone number of host member
    - ✓ Name and phone number of designated life guard
    - ✓ Date & Time of party (4 hour max)
    - √ # of people expected
  - Clean-Up: It is the host's responsibility to clean up immediately after a party. This includes the removal of all trash incurred during the party from the premise of the Hacienda Recreational Club.
  - Failure to follow any of these instructions may result in a \$50 fine.
- 8. Please do not let anyone you don't know inside the pool area. If they are members, they have a key. For security and safety purposes, do not prop open pool door.
- 9. Health and Safety codes require that everyone shower before entering the pool and that no one with open sores, even if bandaged, may enter the pool. The lifeguard will also be enforcing this rule.
- 10. Make sure that you and your guests are signed in every time you use the pool. If you do not bring a quest, just mark "0" for # of quests.
- 11. The rope must be up at all times. Do not pull, stand, or play with it. The only exception is for a lap swimmer to disconnect, but then reconnect after use.
- 12. When a lifeguard is present children over the age of 7 may be left after they have passed a swimming proficiency test and a parent emergency number has been left with the lifeguard. Children over 14 years can be left with the lifeguard. All children must be retrieved before the lifeguard goes off duty.

## Please contact a board member to report any safety issue or vandalism affecting the premises.

- Please remember that parties are a privilege and the pool will NOT be closed to regular members at that time.
- Your children and their invited guests are your responsibility. Please review the requirements listed above with your children/guests so they are properly informed.
- If you are a witness to the safety and/or enjoyment of those at the pool being jeopardized, please notify one of the board members so that immediate action may be taken.
- If you, your child or guests thereof are found disregarding rules and /or causing destruction to the premises of the Hacienda Recreational Club,
  - 1. The first offense will result in a written notice.
  - 2. The second offense will result in a \$100 fine.
  - 3. The third offense will result in automatic termination of membership.

Grievous offenses, as determined by the Board of Directors, may result in any or all of the above penalties.
